



## *The Nihilists*

**Dusk (8-10pm), 16th July, 2011**

PLEASE NOTE: Attendees are responsible for their own safety. Please ensure you are adequately equipped for walking on the mountain at dusk (and in the dark). A torch, map, compass, whistle and rain coat are strongly advised.

### **Directions:**

PLEASE NOTE: this is not a guided walk - please make your own way around the route.

1. From the National Trust Car Park at Mynydd Llanwenarth take the well defined path roughly opposite the car park entrance.
2. Follow this path gently up the hill until it meets a stone wall. At the wall take the right hand fork over the brow of the hill.
3. The first installation (1.) will be located near the brow of the hill. The final location will be dependent on weather conditions.
4. After the installation take the broad path to the left, which runs along near the top of the ridge.

The route is indicated with red dotted lines on the map above. On the ground the route is marked with small yellow and orange lights. Should you get lost please follow these lights back to the car park. If you get really lost, please blow a whistle, call for help (there will be people around until about midnight) or in an emergency, call 999 or 112 and ask for Police, then Mountain Rescue.

5. At the next junction fork left and continue to rejoin the stone wall.
6. Follow the stone wall downhill on a broad track. After 100 yards or so the track bears right, away from the wall. Follow the track across the slope to the edge of a plantation.
7. At the end of the plantation follow the track steeply downhill to a small valley with a stream.
8. At the stream crossing: turn right and follow the stream uphill to visit the second installation (2); and left for Team Sports' performance(3).
9. Retrace your steps to return to the car park, for tea and cake.
10. You can cut out a bit of the return walk by continuing to follow the stone wall at the top of the slope after the plantation. This track rejoins the route at the top of the hill leading down to the car park.
